A scholarship will be awarded to a piano student with the highest mark in each of the following:

- \$150 to a student who has completed Level 9 with theory co-requisites
- \$200 to a student who has completed Level 10 Split (scoring 85 and above) with theory co-requisites
- \$250 to a student who has completed Level 10 Complete (scoring 80 and above) with theory co-requisites

Theory requirements must be fulfilled for both grades. To be eligible for the scholarship, the student must have a mark of 80 or above (with all written subjects) for level 9 and level 10. 85 or above (with all written subjects) for level 10 split (with both parts of the Level 10 examination taken within the same year) from the Royal Conservatory of Music. The student receiving the award must be studying with a teacher of the Richmond Branch of the BCRMTA. Please mail both piano and theory results to the attention of:
